**Notice Regarding Access to Health Information**

By enrolling my child in Community Child Care Center, I acknowledge that my child's file containing health information (*including the health care summary, health history, immunization record, illness visits, health insurance information, Individual Child Care Plan (ICCP), and any follow-up procedures or information regarding abnormal results on a health screening*) is confidential but will be accessed as needed by the Community Child Care Center administrators and classroom teachers. I also understand information pertinent to my child's safety may need to be shared with Community Child Care Center kitchen staff and part time Child Care Workers as indicated to provide safe childcare services. I also understand that my child's confidential health information will be immediately available upon request to regulatory authorities during regulatory visits, including but not limited to Minnesota Department of Human Services - Licensing Division, Minnesota Child Care Health Consultants, or NAEYC. I understand that my child's confidential file will be made available to me (the parents/legal guardians) immediately upon request.

**Notice Regarding Classroom Pets**

**Permission to Perform Developmental Screening**

Community Child Care Center uses the formal screening battery, Minneapolis Preschool Screening Instrument-Revised (MPSI-R). By checking here and signing this form, I give CCCC permission to assess my child with this instrument.

**Permission to Take Walks**

By checking here and signing this form, I give my child permission to take walks with the Community Child Care Center Staff and classmates. The teachers will write when the walks are going to be on the weekly curriculum when possible. If you need to pick your child up during the walk, let a staff person know when you get to CCCC and we will help locate your child's classroom.

**Permission to Participate in Observational Research and Educational Observation**

Community Child Care Center (CCCC) is a designated research facility of the University of Minnesota, and enrolled children are occasionally asked to participate in research projects designed and conducted by faculty and students of the Institute of Child Development as well as other University departments.

As part of enrollment, all parents must sign this permission form for their child to participate in approved observational research. This approval covers the most frequent type of research and training that occurs at CCCC: Observation of children during their normal daily activities.

Parents will be asked for additional signed permission for any research project that involves children in activities that are not a part of their normal daily routine at the Center. During these research sessions children may be asked questions, play games or complete simple tasks. Most children enjoy these activities. Researchers are not interested in singling out any individual child's performance, but rather in collecting group performance data. Parents will be informed of these ongoing research projects.

The children's comfort, well-being, and minimal disturbance to their daily routines are always foremost considerations. Teachers may decide to defer a child's participation because of fatigue or interest in other activities.

Occasionally parents are also asked to participate in research, and sometimes CCCC receives request from local news stations or newspapers to photograph children at CCCC and/or to interview parents and children about topics related to child care. Additional signed permission from parents will be obtained for participation in such activities.

CCCC reserves the right for its staff to photograph or videotape all enrolled children for educational or observational
